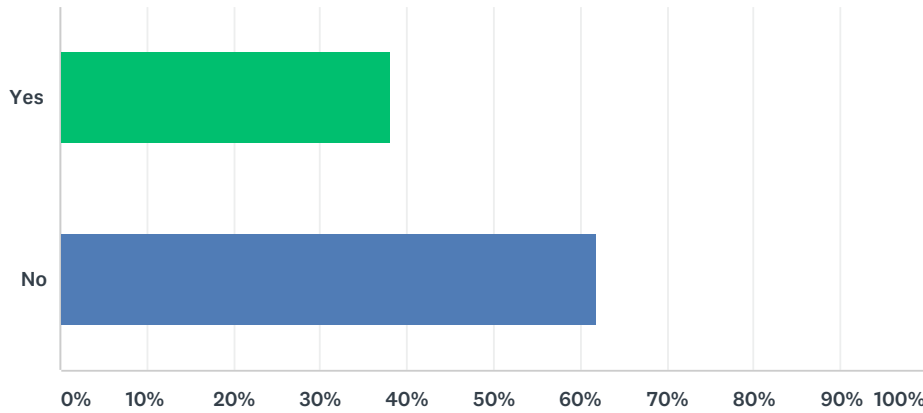


Q1 The Forest Products Machinery & Equipment Exposition has been held every other year since 1950. Was this your first time attending?

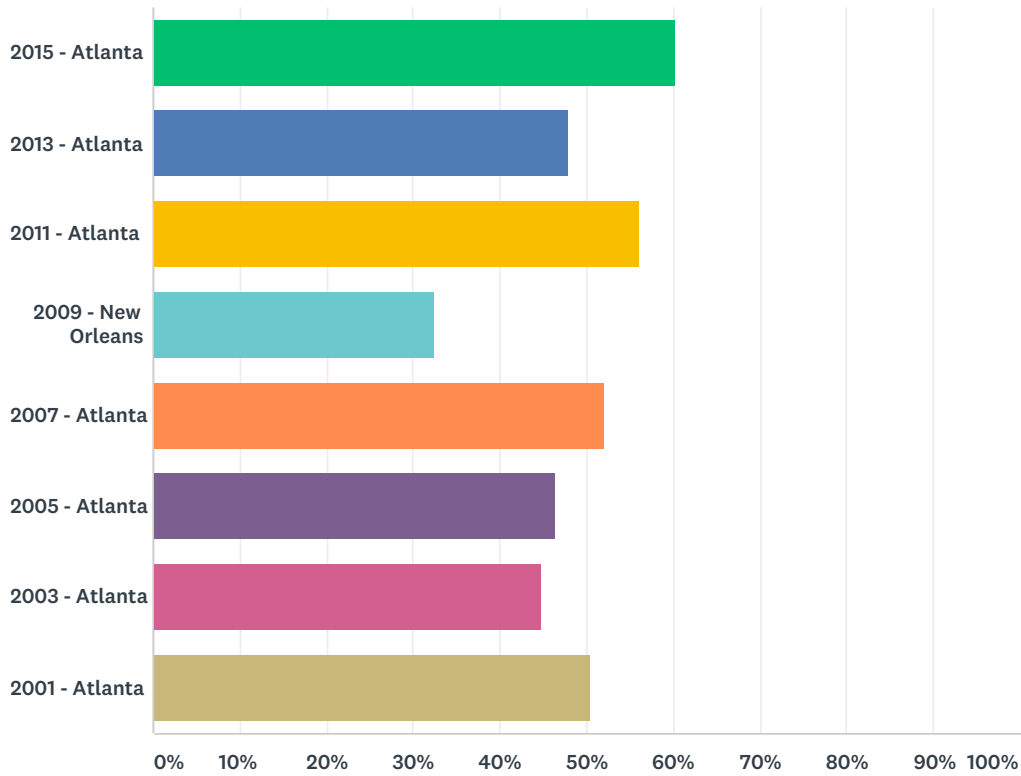

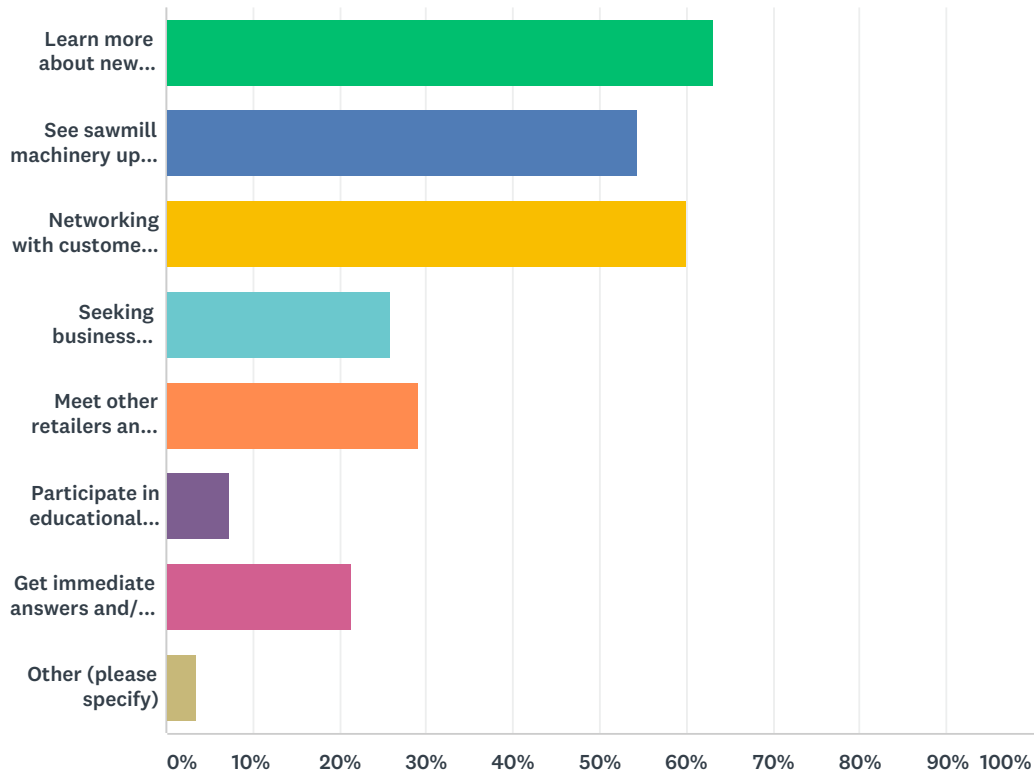

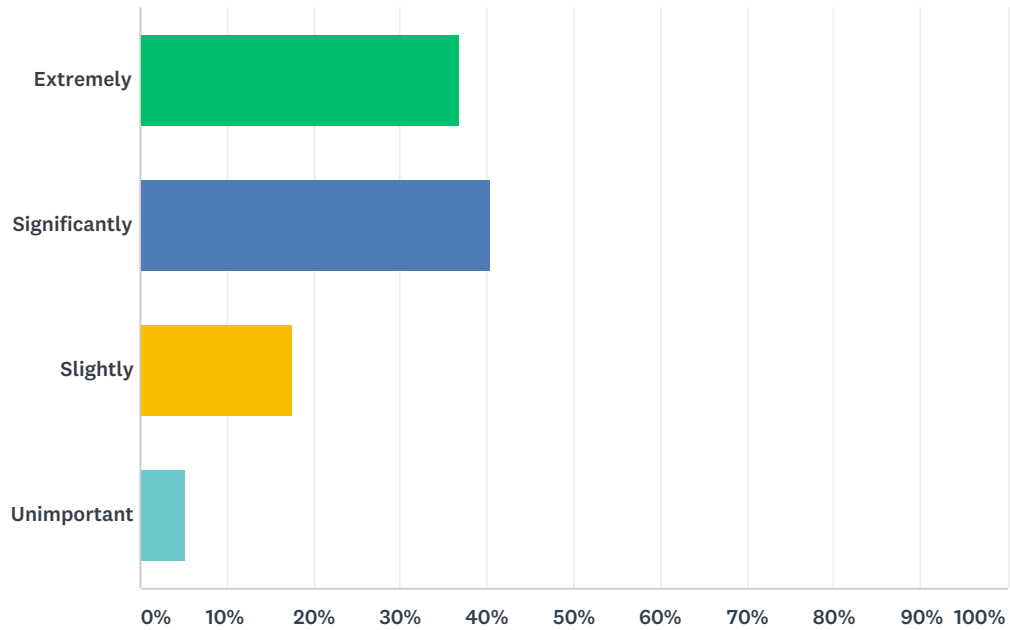

Q4 How important is it for you to see sawmill machinery on display.

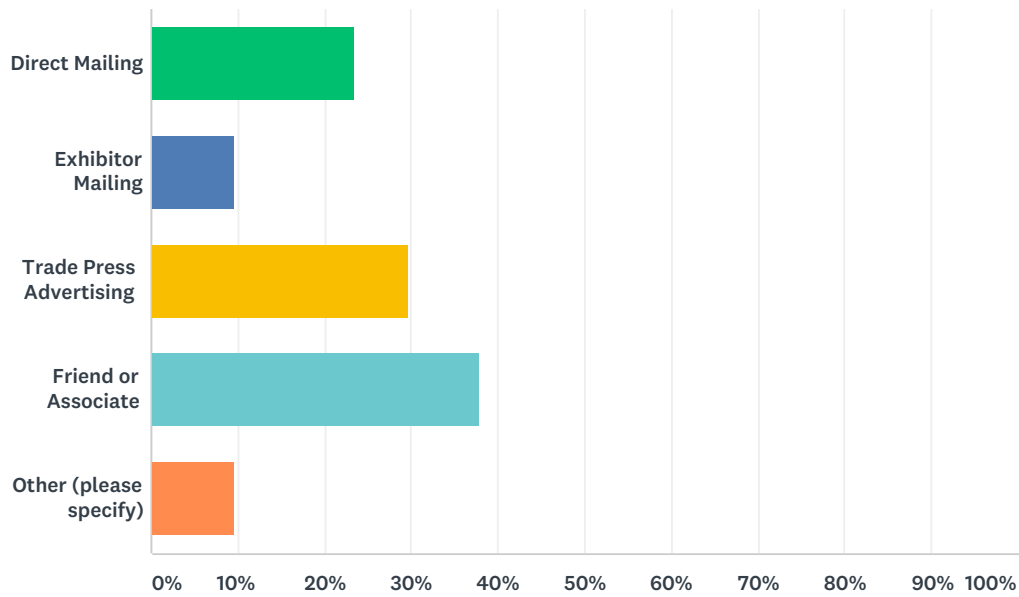

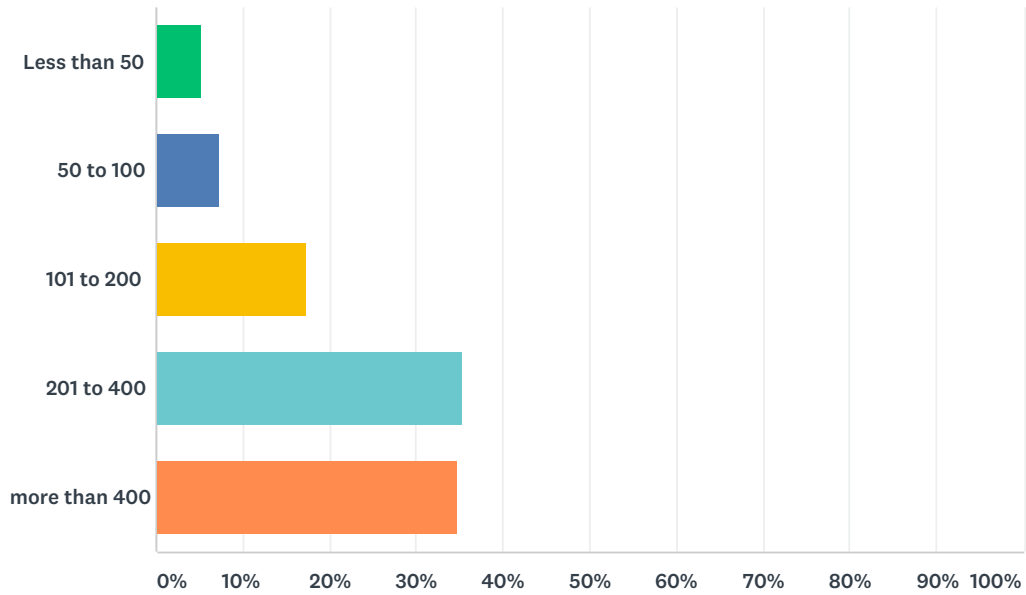

Q6 How many miles did you travel to attend to the show?

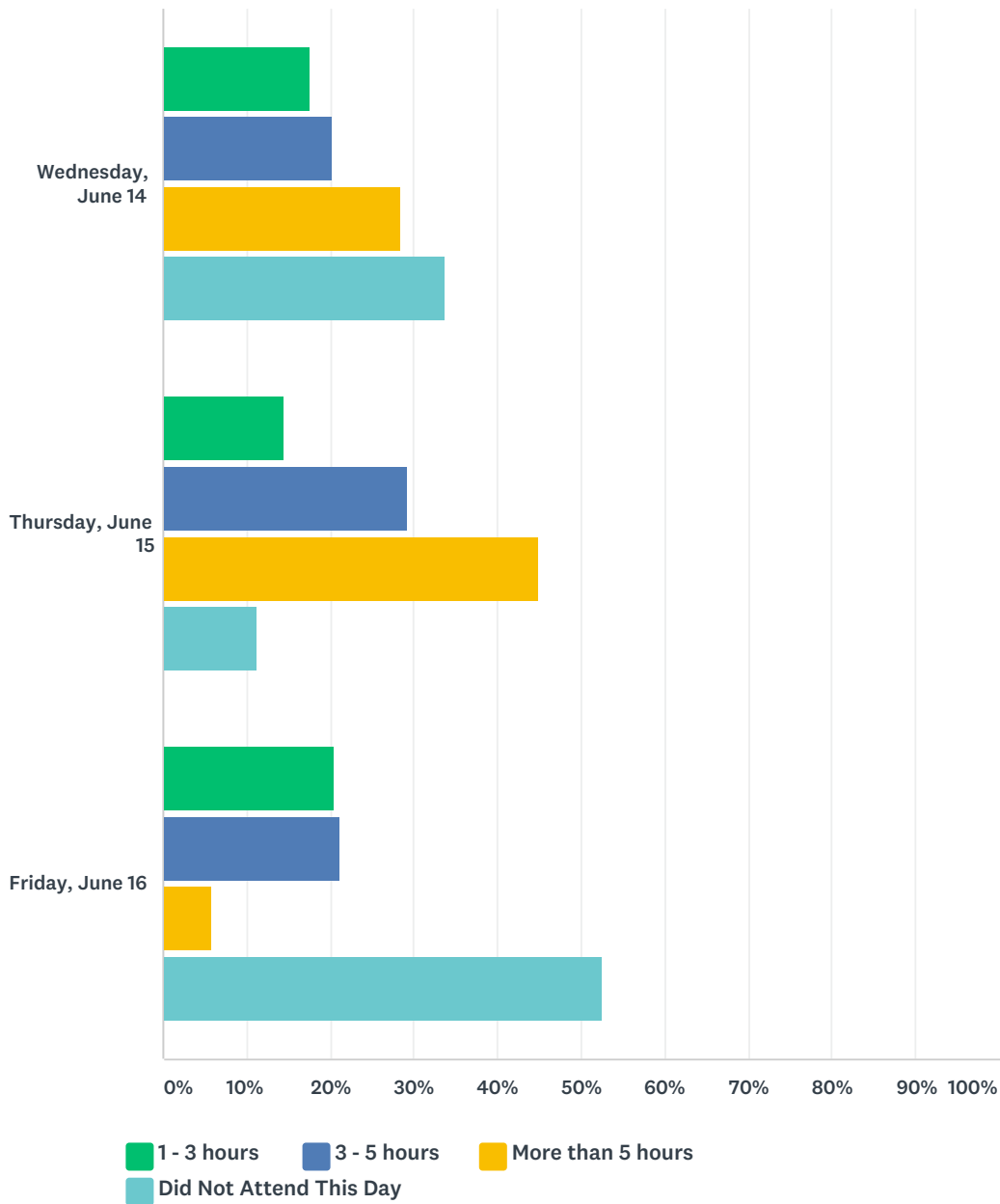

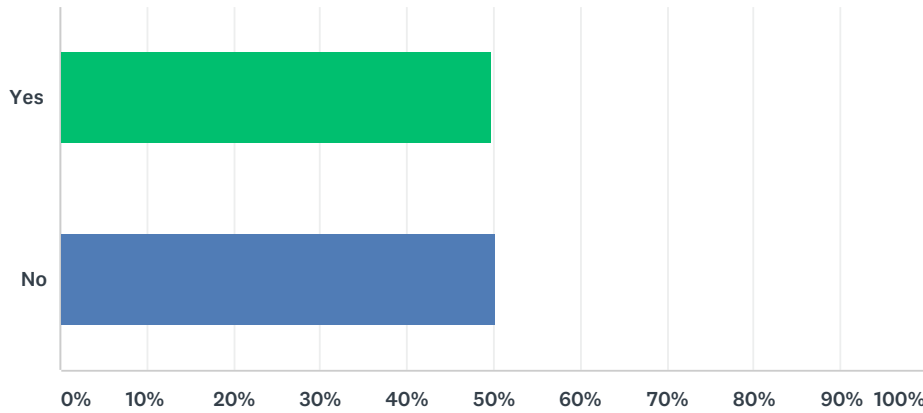
